Entry Changes/Move-ups

Refunds

To receive a refund, the Trial Secretary must be notified before the trial date by a competitor whose bitch comes into season or whose dog is injured, and a valid veterinarian certificate must be provided prior to any refund being issued. There will be no refunds for dogs pulled on actual days of the trial, except for bitches in heat. Covid-19 exception: A full refund will be issued if the handler is sick, or has been in contact with a sick person, and is on self-isolation due to Covid -19 provided that the handler notifies the Trial Secretary of their illness. Refunds for any other reasons may or may not be given at the Trial Committee's discretion. Coupons issued by P.A.C.E. are not redeemable for cash. ***Please note that there will be no refund of entry fees for any dog or handler excused from the trial for any reason.***

Ribbons & Rosettes

Ribbons for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th places and qualifying runs, will be given in each jump height category. Rosettes will be given for any ADC, ADC, MADC, ATChC, Bronze, Silver, Gold & Lifetime Achievement titles.

Concession

Neitak will provided a high quality hot and cold concession.

Class Descriptions

Regular Classes: Open to all dogs, 18 months of age or older, as described within the current rules of the Agility Association of Canada.

Specials Classes: Open to all dogs but are intended for dogs that are of a size or stature which limits their jumping ability. Dog will jump one height lower than listed regular height.

Veterans Classes: These classes shall be for dogs seven years of age or older that are currently competing in any Regular Class and for dogs five years of age or older who have competed in the Specials Class level for a minimum of twelve months. At owner's discretion, the dog can jump one or two heights below the listed regular height.

Junior Handlers:

Open to handlers 17 years and under, dog will jump 1 height lower than current jump height. Junior Handlers can compete in all games and standard classes.

Senior Handler and Disabled Handler:

Senior handlers (65 years and older) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time & points. Proof of age or disability is not required but handler must indicate on the entry form if entering in this. Dog will be entered in their current competition jump height and category.

Directions

Neitak Equestrian Centre is located 20 km south of Stony Plain on Hwy 779.

Directions from Edmonton Hwy 16A:

Go west on Hwy 16A until you hit Hwy 60 to Devon. Go south on Hwy 60 until you get to Hwy 627. Go west on Hwy 627 to Hwy 779 (Range Road 10). (Note: the street signs increase to Rge Rd 280 and then drop to Rge Rd 10). Go south on Hwy 779 for 12 km; you will pass a "No exit" sign but keep going the full 12 km. Look for the first farm on the right after Township Road 505 (50416 Rge Rd 10). You'll see the "Neitak Equestrian" sign on the entrance gate.

Directions from Anthony Henday:

Take the 184 street exit at Cameron Heights going west and follow the round until you can turn right onto 23 Ave. This road will become Garden Valley Road and eventually becomes Hwy 627. Go west on Hwy 627 to Hwy 779 (Range Road 10). Go south on Hwy 779 for 12 km; you will pass a "No exit" sign but keep going the full 12 km. Look for the first farm on the right after Township Road 505 (50416 Rge Rd 10). You'll see the "Neitak Equestrian" sign on the entrance gate.

Bitches in Season

P.A.C.E. is looking forward to participating in AAC's bitches in season (BIS) pilot project allowing a BIS to compete at the trial. Please be advised failure to abide by the pilot program rules set out by AAC may lead to BIS no longer being allowed to run at any future AAC events.

Rules:

- Handlers are required to notify the trial secretary that they are running a BIS as soon as it is known.
- BIS are required to wear protective panties at all times except when in the ring and in their designated potty area.
- A protective mat (provided by the handler) must be used at the start line.
- Handlers/ Owners are required to minimize the exposure of their BIS to other dogs and limit their movements around the trial grounds. This includes using the BIS designated potty area only.

Covid Requirement

Any rules from Alberta Health will be followed.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by the AAC and Performance Agility Club Of Edmonton (the “Organizing Club”) and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the “Event”), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including, but not limited to, serious injuries, death, exposure to and/or infection by the COVID-19 virus) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my “**Related Parties**”), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the “**Personnel**”) for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or

costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers’ fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to: (a) any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or (b) aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
