Crating Available:

Overnight benching is located in the horse stalls on the south side of the trial ring area. Please keep the walkway area clear for competitors and dogs to pass by safely and comfortably. You are required to bring your own chairs, crates and pens. We would ask that you bench your dogs in crates where possible.

Entry Limits:

500 Runs Per Day

Move Ups:

There will be no same day move-ups. Next day move-ups will be accepted.

Day of Show Entries:

Day of Show entries are not accepted. Competitors already entered in the trial may add additional runs to their original entry, if desired.

Refunds:

Refunds will not be given for dogs that are pulled on or after November 06, 2024, or on the actual days of the trial. Coupons issued by P.A.C.E. are not redeemable for cash. Coupons submitted with trial entries will not be returned unless P.A.C.E. has refused an exhibitor's entry. Please note that there will be no refund of entry fees for any dog or handler excused from the trial for any reason.

Confirmations and any other information regarding the trial will be e-mailed to the owner of the dog(s) no later than November 05, 2024. *If you do not receive your confirmation by November 05, 2024, please notify the Trial Secretary.*

Food Info:

Neitak Equestrian Centre offers an on-site concession. Quality hot and cold, breakfast and lunch items, beverages and snacks will be available.

Volunteer Info:

There will be a volunteer sign-up sheet at the trial for each day of the trial. In appreciation of our volunteers, we offer punch card coupons. Each punch is worth \$0.50 Coupons are redeemable towards entry fees for future P.A.C.E. trials.

Awards and Ribbons:

Placement ribbons will be awarded to fourth place in each jump height for each class, in each category, except Chances which is a pass / fail class. A purple qualifying ribbon shall be given for each qualifying round in each class. Ribbons are also offered for NATCH and Versatility Titles. *There will be a Q/NQ prize draw for each day of the trial.*

Equipment Info:

Actual trial ring is enclosed on all four sides, either by the physical walls of the arena or by fencing, except for the ring entrance and exit points.

Dogs which require measuring:

Dogs in the Proficient Category: Novice, Open or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12" or 16"

Dogs which do not need to be measured:

Dogs jumping 16" in the Veteran or Junior Handler Division Dogs jumping 20" Dogs in the Skilled Category Dogs with a permanent height card Dogs listed on the Height Exemption List

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20". There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16". There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16". Please see the NADAC Rulebook for the full jump height table

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to <u>www.nadac.com</u> for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Cheques not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$45.00 NSF service charge for bank returned cheques.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <u>https://www.nadac.com/register-your-dog</u> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a small container (Ziploc bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. All handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitors Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is an accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the Province in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner acknowledges the contagious nature of COVID-19 and all variants of COVID-19, and voluntarily assumes the risk of exposure or infection by COVID-19 and any variant of COVID-19, as a result of attending and/or participating this NADAC trial. As an exhibitor/owner, I/we accept sole responsibility for my/our decision to attend and/or participate this NADAC trial. Exhibitor/owner further accepts sole responsibility for any personal injury, disability, illness, death, damage, loss, claim, liability or expenses of any kind in connection with, or as a result of attending and/or participating in this NADAC trial.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **Performance Agility Club of Edmonton (P.A.C.E.)** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and **Neitak Equestrian Ltd.** (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Neitak Equestrian Centre is located 20 kilometres south of Stony Plain on Highway 779. Look for the first farm on the right, after Township Road 505. Enter through the gate located just past the private residence.

From North or East (within Edmonton area):

West on Yellowhead Trail to Highway 779. South on Highway 779.

From South or West (within Edmonton area):

Anthony Henday to Cameron Heights/184 Street Exit. South on 184 Street to 23 Avenue. Turn West onto 23 Avenue which becomes Highway 627. Continue West on Highway 627 to Highway 779 (Range Road 10). Note: the Range Road signs on Highway 627 increase to Range Road 280 and then drop to Range Road 10 as you continue west.

From North (outside Edmonton area):

South on Highway 28 to Highway 37. West on Highway 37 to Highway 779. South on Highway 779.

From South (outside Edmonton area):

North on Queen Elizabeth Highway (Highway 2) to Highway 19 (Nisku Overpass). West on Highway 19 to Highway 60. North on Highway 60 to Highway 627. West on Highway 627 to Highway 779 (Range Road 10). Note: the Range Road signs on Highway 627 increase to Range Road 280 and then drop to Range Road 10 as you continue west.

From East (outside Edmonton area):

West on Yellowhead Trail to Highway 779. South on Highway 779.

From West (outside Edmonton area):

East on Highway 16 to Highway 779. South on Highway 779.

PARKING AT TRIAL SITE

Parking is limited to the south side of the arena complex along the fence line only. No parking is allowed up against the arena complex or near the private residence areas located close to the entrance gate onto the property.

P.A.C.E. TRIAL RULES

When not competing, dogs must be penned, crated or leashed. Dogs must be under control at all times when entering and exiting the trial ring and warm-up area. Exhibitors are required to supply their own chairs, crates/pens for benching.

Exhibitors must keep benching and exercise areas clean. *Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.* Anyone who does not do this may be excused from the trial by the Show Committee.

Any dog demonstrating aggression towards a person or dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, will be excused from the trial. Aggression does not mean there must be actual physical contact.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his/her owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. P.A.C.E. will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site.

In accordance with P.A.C.E. policy, a dog or handler that has been suspended for any reason by any organization that sanctions competitive dog events of any kind will not be allowed entry into the trial.
